Founder's Letter

Dear friends and collaborators,

Allow me to extend our warmest greetings together with the report of the activities performed in 2020.

This year, as you may already know, has not only been complicated due to the COVID-19 crisis, but also because of the ETA and IOTA hurricanes. I would like to begin this letter by showing my unconditional support, and that of the entire Veron Foundation team, to the many people who have been affected by these circumstances. We would also like to share our affection and strength for us to overcome this difficult time together.

These strange times of lockdowns and mobility restrictions have prevented us from executing some of the projects planned for 2020, and as a result, we created some new activities.

As you know, our initial project and from which the rest of the other projects have emerged, is Escuela del Vidrio. This school is the first step to a huge life changer for many young people and their families; since after that, they have the opportunity to access a series of programs, such as university scholarships, microcredits for development or the entrepreneurs' community, that will open their path to a bright future.

2020 has made things complicated. Not only were we forced to close the school for a matter of health and security, but we also started the year with a threat of extortion. Thankfully, we were able to overcome this obstacle with courage and strength, which brought us even closer.

This bond allowed us to improve and adjust the schooling program to an online format. Still, this was a big challenge for us, from which we learned how to move forward, based on empathy and solidarity.

And above all, thanks to our teachers, who have looked after each and every one of our students, that were struggling with their personal situations, besides trying not to miss their academic training. Therefore, I give my most sincere congratulations to all the educators for their effort and ability to adapt to this special situation. Your dedication has been outstanding and for that, I convey our most sincere recognition and admiration.

Another terrible consequence of the pandemic, which we once again overcame as a team, was the shutdown of businesses and the consequent loss of employment in Honduras. This led us to the need of an articulated system to distribute food supplies and hygiene products for the families affected. It was thanks to our local partner, the AEV NGDO, that we were able to help so many people.

Last and for all, to all the beneficiaries and their families, I would like to congratulate them for having remained constant in their learning, studying and entrepreneuring path. Overcoming all the difficulties without any extra-support from the school, which is the point of reference and security in the community, has shown an incredible enthusiasm, solidarity and perseverance for what you do.

Up to this point, we have done well, very well I would say. Even if we are uncertain about what the next few months will be like, one thing is true: we have learned how to manage and survive in a changing world, which will increase our ability to work as a team and adapt to any kind of situation.

About Nacar Foundation

The Nacar Foundation was founded in 2005 with the aim of supporting needy children and young people in disadvantaged situations and countries.

The project's focus relies on training young Hondurans in the mid-term, to help them escape poverty. The main project is the management of an educational school in Honduras ("Escuela del Vidrio"). At Escuela del Vidrio, young people in Honduras at risk of social exclusion receive a three-year academic training in several subjects such as mathematics, English, sports, Spanish or history, supported by other technical trainings oriented towards a future profession.

Escuela del Vidrio

(School of Glass)



LOCATION

Aldea del Porvenir del Norte, El Progreso. Yoro, Honduras. C.A.

THE PROJECT

The Escuela del Vidrio in Honduras, born in 2009, is an educational project meant to foster international cooperation and which continues every day with our ongoing support. Since 2015, the school has been located in the village of El Porvenir del Norte (Camalote), north of the city of El Progreso, Yoro, Honduras. Its main goal is to train young people so they can have access to a job opportunity and develop a decent life.

Escuela del Vidrio provides for low-income youngsters from rural areas, who otherwise would not have access to an education. In fact, it offers them a three-year professional training in glass crafts or cooking and tourism, under the certification of CONEANFO (National Commission for the Development of Non-Formal Alternative Education). At the same time, they take the Basic Cycle exam (formal education) thanks to an agreement with IHER (Honduran Institute of Education by Radio) and can also access a Bachelor's degree.

Even if 2020 was complicated, as we were forced to close the school, we were able to continue with the academic year. We faced the digital gap squarely, even though the teachers had to make a huge effort to continue with the theoretical classes. We took desktop computers from the school to create network points in the most remote communities. The students were connected according to their possibilities, since they only had one device at home, usually belonging to a relative, and they could not afford the cost of the Internet.

BENEFICIARIES

Low-income youth from rural communities in the city of El Progreso, Yoro, aged 15 to 18, who have completed 6th grade of basic cycle, and who due to varied circumstances have no options to study. Their attitude of improvement encourages them to want to continue their studies and access quality employment.
